OG 2020 Qualification system - explanations

Dear Member Federations,

In addition to the *Qualification System – Games of the XXXII Olympiad-Tokyo2020* you can find some important information and clarification below.

Direct Qualification Events

- Direct Continental Qualification Events must be held during the period 1 January 2019 to 31 December 2019
- The maximum number of athletes per gender and nation for each event is four (4) athletes, according to UIPM competition rules for all Olympic Qualification events (R 1.12.8)

According to Qualification System there will be UIPM Direct Qualification events. In addition, each Continent will have a direct Continental Qualification Event. The following dates and places have been confirmed:

Note

Please read carefully the allocation of quota places in Section D (Qualification Pathway) and Section F (Reallocation of unused quota places and unused qualification places) in the *Qualification System – Games of the XXXII Olympiad-Tokyo2020*

Qualification competition for Olympic Pentathlon World Ranking list (OPWR)

Only below listed OPWR competition during the period of June 1, 2019 – May 31, 2020 will count towards OPWR.

- Only one (1) competition of the same type (WCH, WCF, CCH), the most recent one during the qualification period, will count towards OPWR. (R 1.19.1)
e.g. World, Continental Championships, World Cup Final, Continental Championships

2019 UIPM World Cup Final will NOT count towards OPWR

2020 UIPM World Cup Final will count towards OPWR

2019 UIPM World Championships will NOT count towards OPWR

2020 UIPM World Championships will count towards OPWR

Only the most recent Continental Championships, during the period June 1, 2019 – May 31, 2020 will count towards OPWR.

*In case of the American continent only Pan American competitions (Games or Championships) count towards OPWR. South and NORCECA championships do not count.

Season 2019:

- July 4 - 7, 2019 Belarus Open, BLR
- September 12 - 15, 2019 Polish Open, POL
- September 26 - 29, 2019 Kyrgyzstan Open, KGZ

Season 2020:

- January 2020 Budapest Indoor, HUN
- April/ May 2020 US Open, USA
- World Cup 1,2,3,4 TBC
- May 2020 UIPM World Cup Final 2020, Seoul, KOR
- May 2020 UIPM World Championships, Xiamen, CHN

- OPWR points will be attributed according to level and criteria as outlined in UIPM Competition rules. (R. 1.19.2)
- The maximum number per gender and nation is four (4) athletes. If there are free places, the host nation may compete with 6 athletes per gender if the event is not a direct Olympic Qualification event. (R 1.12.8)
